



City of Brush 2019 Election Calendar for the Nov. 5 Coordinated Election

Upon Candidacy	Candidate Affidavit due within ten (10) days of becoming a candidate.
Monday , August 5	Candidate information meeting at City Hall Council Chambers at 7 pm
Tuesday, August 6	First Day that a nomination petition for municipal office may be circulated and signed. (91 days before the election). Petitions are obtained from the Brush City Clerk. They must have at least 25 valid signatures by registered electors (for council candidates the electors must have resided in their ward for one year prior to the election). C.R.S. 1-4-805, C.R.S. 31-10-301
Monday, August 19	Last day for municipality to sign an IGA with the County Clerk for a coordinated election (70 days before the election).
Mon7/19/2019day, August 26	Last day to file nomination petition with the City Clerk by 5 pm for municipal office (71 days before the election). C.R.S. 1-4-805
Thursday, August 29	Last day for Nomination Petition signatures, if determined by the City Clerk to be insufficient, may be amended, corrected or replaced (before the sixty-seventh day before the election). C.R.S. 1-4-805
Friday, August 30	Last day for write in candidates to file an affidavit of intent with the City Clerk. (by the close of business on the sixty-fourth day before the election.) CRS 1-4-1102(2)
Tuesday, September 3	Ballot order determined at City Hall at 5:30 p.m.
Friday, September 6	Last day for the designated election official from each political subdivision that intends to conduct an election to certify the ballot content. If the election will be coordinated with the county, the certification must be delivered to the county clerk and recorder of each county that has territory within the political subdivision. (no later than 60 days before the election) C.R.S. 1-1-110(3), 1-5-203(3) and 31-2-210(3.5)
Monday, October 14	Earliest date for mailing of ballots by county clerk
Tuesday, October 15	Campaign report due to City Clerk per Fair Campaign Practices Act
Friday, October 18	Latest date for mailing of ballots by county clerk
Friday, November 1	Campaign report due to City Clerk per Fair Campaign Practices Act
Tuesday, November 5	Coordinated Election
Thursday, December 5	Campaign report due to City Clerk per Fair Campaign Practices Act
