Here is an opportunity to serve your community. City Council has the following openings:

Mayor elected at large, 4 year term, paid \$600 per month.

One Councilor from each of the three wards in the City of Brush, 4 year term, paid \$300 per month.

Ward I Running north and south - west side of Hospital Road to west City limits

Ward II Running north and south - east side of Hospital Road to west side of Carson Street

Ward III Running north and south - east side of Carson Street to east City limits

In order to get your name on the November 7, 2017, ballot for city council, nomination petitions must be obtained from the City Clerk, at City Hall, 600 Edison Street, Brush, Colorado, and circulated beginning **Tuesday, August 8, 2017, and submitted to the city clerk by 5 p.m. Monday, August 28, 2017.**

Candidates must be 18 years of age, a United States citizen, a registered elector by the date of the election. The Mayor must have resided within city limits and Councilors must have resided in their specific ward for 12 consecutive months prior to the election.
