**CEMETERY SEASONAL WORKER**

**General Statement of Duties:** Performs a variety of unskilled tasks at the entry level in the Cemetery Department. Answers to the Cemetery Lead Worker and the Parks and Cemetery Supervisor.

**Examples of Duties:**

The following duty statements are not intended and should not be interpreted to be an exhaustive list of all responsibilities or skills associated with this position. Other duties and responsibilities are performed as assigned.

- Performs clean up, painting and maintenance.
- Assists other employees in carrying out tasks.
- Uses simple tools and equipment including the operation of push mowers, riding mowers and weed eaters.
- Does related work as required.

**Job Requirements and Difficulty of Work:**

Skill in using simple tools; ability to follow instructions; good physical health and ability; capable of learning new tasks and skills.

Must have valid Colorado driver's license.

The employee shall work well under pressure, meet multiple and sometimes competing deadlines.

The employee shall at all times demonstrate cooperative behavior with colleagues and supervisors.

**Physical Effort and Work Environment:**

The job's physical demand requirements place the position in the **Heavy** category according to the U.S. Dept of Labor's Dictionary of Occupational Titles, Volume II, Fourth Edition, Revised 1991.

Occasional (1%-33%), Frequent (34%-66%), Constant (67%-100%)

Requires sitting, climbing, overhead reaching and twisting occasionally.

Requires crawling and kneeling frequently.

Requires standing, walking, squatting, stooping, carrying, angular reaching, wrist flexion/extension, elbow flexion/extension, supination/pronation and grasping constantly.

Must be able to overhead push 8 pounds frequently.

Must be able to ascend and descend a 12 ft. ladder occasionally.

Must be able to pull/push 49 pounds up to 25 ft. occasionally.

Must be able to carry various hand tools and ladder frequently.

Must be able to carry 50 pounds up to 5 ft. occasionally.

Must be able to lift: 62 pounds from ground level to 42 inches occasionally and 50 pounds from ground level to 42 inches occasionally.

Maximum lift is 62 pounds.

Exposed to outdoor weather conditions, temperature changes, wet or humid conditions not related to weather, noise, confined spaces, fumes/dust/dirt and vibrations.

Must be able to perform in adverse weather conditions.

Must be able to work at moderate heights in trees.

**Education:**

High School education or equivalent preferred but not required.

**Experience:**

No experience required.
